

VILLAGE COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
March 7, 2022

The Lincoln Village Council met on Monday March 7, 2022 at 7 p.m. at the Village Hall. Those in attendance included President Phillips, Treasurer Mahalak, Clerk Somers and Council Members Durham, Healy, Putsky, Schick, Somers and Wambold. The minutes of the February meeting were approved on a motion from Wambold with support from Somers. The Treasurer's report was approved subject to audit on a motion from Healy with support from Wambold. The bills were approved for payment on a motion from Wambold with support from Healy. Budget amendments were made on a motion from Schick with support from Wambold.

Lenny Avery joined the meeting via telephone regarding the need to explore options for a sewer and water system for the Village. He stated that there is a lot of funding to aid in the development of a system. He would like to have someone from the Village Council volunteer to be a part of a committee. President Phillips advised that there were need to be 51+% of the Village residents want to have a sewer and waste water system. They would then need to petition the Council to have a system put in the community. President Phillips and Joe James agreed to be a part of the committee. Putsky gave the Sewer report. Things are doing well currently. He suggested that we may want to get one more new pump to have in reserve. One application was received for the maintenance man position that was advertised. A motion was made by Healy to accept the application and to authorize the HR committee to interview and hire the applicant if they feel he is qualified for the job. Durham offered support. Motion carried. Parks & Rec report was given. The Village Council approved moving \$2980 from Recreational Improvement to the Playground Fund to use for new Fibar Mulch and re-sealing the Flights of Imagination Playground. Volunteers will be needed when we do these projects. Anyone interested may contact Sara Healy at 989-335-1061. Durham gave the maintenance report since Warren is on vacation. President Phillips gave her road report. Clerk Somers will work with Mike Suitor on updating the Village Website. A questionnaire is on the Village website regarding how to spend ARPA funds. Village residents are urged to log on and look at it and leave their comments at lincolnmi.com. A motion to adjourn was made by Healy with support from Schick. Carried.
