**2020 Village of Lincoln List of Potential EDC Projects**

1. Secure funding to repair the drainage issue at the corner of Second Street and Traverse Bay Rds. (near Alcona Motors & South towards the industrial park.
2. New well at the restrooms/concession stand & ball fields.
3. Help secure much needed fire equipment. (Mike - please prioritize)
4. Extend Traverse Bay Rd. Streetscape Project to Barlow Rd.
5. New Community Building to house the Village Offices, with a larger Conference Room, and space for the ACCOA (assuming they would like to move). Then we could turn the old Village Hall over to the Fire Department.
