June 3, 2024 President's Report

• 5/14/2024 DDA Meeting – discussion held with regards to trimming the trees in the Streetscape. Bob Szuber provided Mr. James with a quote of \$125 per tree. Work to begin in July, after the trees have bloomed.

Beginning on 7/8/2024 the NE MI Healthy Food project will begin setting up on Tuesdays to sell produce on 2nd Street across from Alcona Motors.

The streetlights are all working on 2nd Street. Drivers for the lights have been replace at a cost of \$1,501.55.

Mr. James is helping the Village with new barrier concrete blocks down at the beach area. Each block can stop up to 3500 pounds. This will provide a safer barrier for the public beach.

• 5/20/2024 Planning Commission Meeting – discussion was held with regards to updating the Village Master Plan, Parks and Recreation Plan and Zoning Ordinance. Ms. Goldstrom brought up removing her home from the DDA District. She was referred to the DDA, as the Planning Commission does not set the boundaries.

I spoke with Sheriff Stevenson with regards to allowing Marijuana sales within the Village. He shared with me that the fees collected go to enforcement of the law that applies to the facilities. Food for thought, is there enough revenue from the fees to pay for a constable to enforce the law? The Sheriff indicated that his department will not contract with us to do the job.

Spoke with Gary, and he was going to see if he could get a second quote for repaving at the Lake Street Culvert.

<u>Other</u>

5/7/2024 I spoke with Ron Stout regarding the areas which his crew did not mow. He said he would see to it that it gets done. I had him call Marsha with regards to the billing.

I spoke with Mr. St. John with Inspiration Alcona. They are willing to host the Village for the musical events, under their permits. I indicated that to keep it clean, I would draw up an agreement, which he is welcome to adjust.

6/8/2024 10AM - ARA Site there will be a work bee to mow and trim. The Public is welcome to bring your lawn equipment and put in some community service time. Assistance is always appreciated.
